Feeding learners from destitute families to ensure that they go to school with food.



Apart from such short-term assistance, we continuously search for and deliver effective solutions, designed to give effect to long-term change, developing and implementing small-scale self-help agricultural projects within needy communities, empowering them to improve food security levels.



WATER AND SANITATION

The key challenges to our communities are access to water and sanitation. While we are all entirely dependent on water for life, for some communities it is impossible for people to have access to water. Sanitation has been a challenge in our country for many years.
